Stage 1 of the Wandoan South Project

The Wandoan South Project (WSP), a Renewable Public Utility capable of offering solar generation and battery storage to the National Electricity Market, was approved by the Western Downs Regional Council in August of 2017.

The WSP was approved for development across 3 stages, with the capacity to generate a maximum of 1000MW of electricity from solar and store 450MW of electricity through battery storage. The first BESS component of the WSP will provide for 100MW of the 450MW of the approved battery storage capacity.

Vena Energy Australia will be holding a Community Information
Session in April of 2020, to provide the Wandoan and wider Western
Downs communities an opportunity to meet and greet with the
project team and our construction partners.
